The position of the sculpture would now be to the left of the reception building, and school governors were keen to also include a Mediterranean Garden close to the sculpture.</p> <p>Sollner Room – The school we planning the official opening of the Sollner Room and were hoping that members of Roland Sollner’s family would be able to attend the opening. Simon Barford had done a painting of Roland which will be hung in the Sollner Room. Matt Alexander would arrange for a plaque to be made, ideally from oak.
