THANKS

Term continues to progress well. WRAP AROUND CARE

MENU

We are pleased to be able to offer hot meals again, albeit on a slightly restricted menu. Meals cost £2.20 (unless your child is in Reception, Year 1 or 2). Please try to keep your account in credit - reminder texts will be sent out if an outstanding balance of £11 or more is accrued.

PARKING

When dropping children off in the mornings, and picking up at 3pm, please ensure that cars are parked legally and sensibly so that traffic can flow through the village unimpeded. There are some large vehicles passing through, as well as the service and school buses. Thanks

RESTRICTIONS

To minimise the amount of equipment moving from home to school and vice versa, we are asking for children to **only** bring water bottles, lunch bags and coats into school. Nursery children may also bring a change of clothing which will be left in school unless used. The children will only bring home water bottle and lunch box in addition to their reading record on a Monday. The Reading record needs to be returned the following Friday.
