SCHOOL SPIDER APP - ABSENCE REPORTING



You can now report any child absences by logging into the website on the downloaded App or via the desktop website. A number of parents have already

used this and found it quite easy to use. An absence report that has been 'accepted' does not necessarily mean the absence has been authorised.

WHAT3WORDS

"In an emergency, can you tell us exactly where you are? Street addresses aren't



accurate enough to specify precise locations, such as building entrances, and don't exist for parks and many rural areas.

This makes it hard to find places and prevents people from describing exactly where help is needed in an emergency. Around the world, emergency services are using what3words to find and help people in need.

WHAT3WORDS

What3Words is a free app designed so people can easily relay location information without the hassle of having to find GPS coordinates or longwinded instructions such as "across the field with the burnt oak tree near the pond".

Instead every 3m square in the UK has been assigned a three word address which can be given to emergency service call handlers.

The app is free to use and can be downloaded from your mobile devices app store".
