Can you match the member of staff to their favourite book?



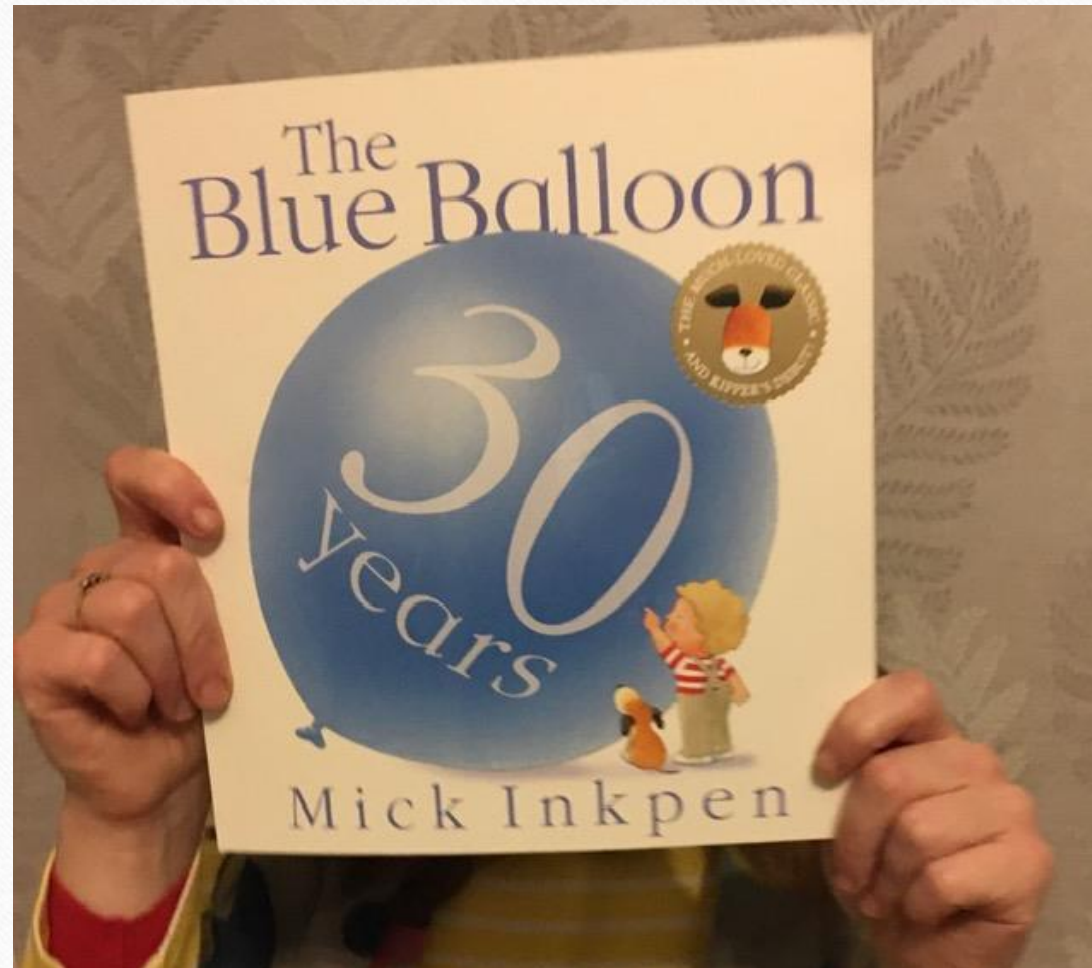
This member of staff has left you some clues next to their favourite book so that you can guess who they might be! Their favourite book when they were little was “Boy” by Roald Dahl.





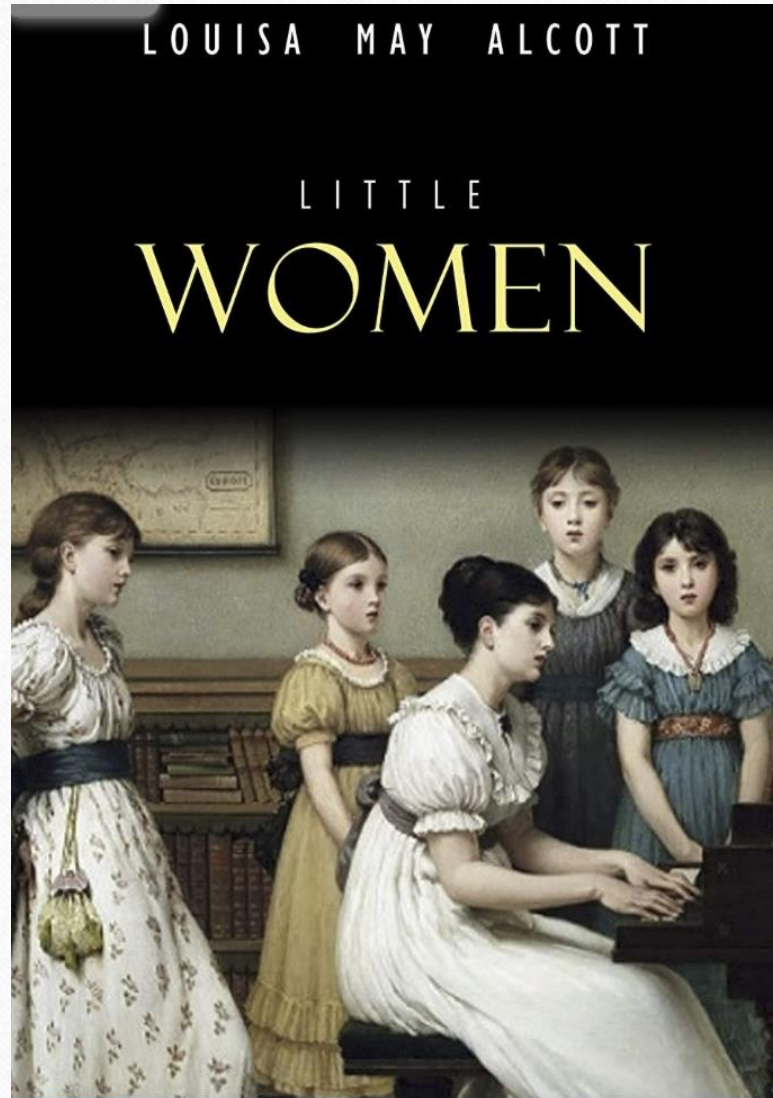

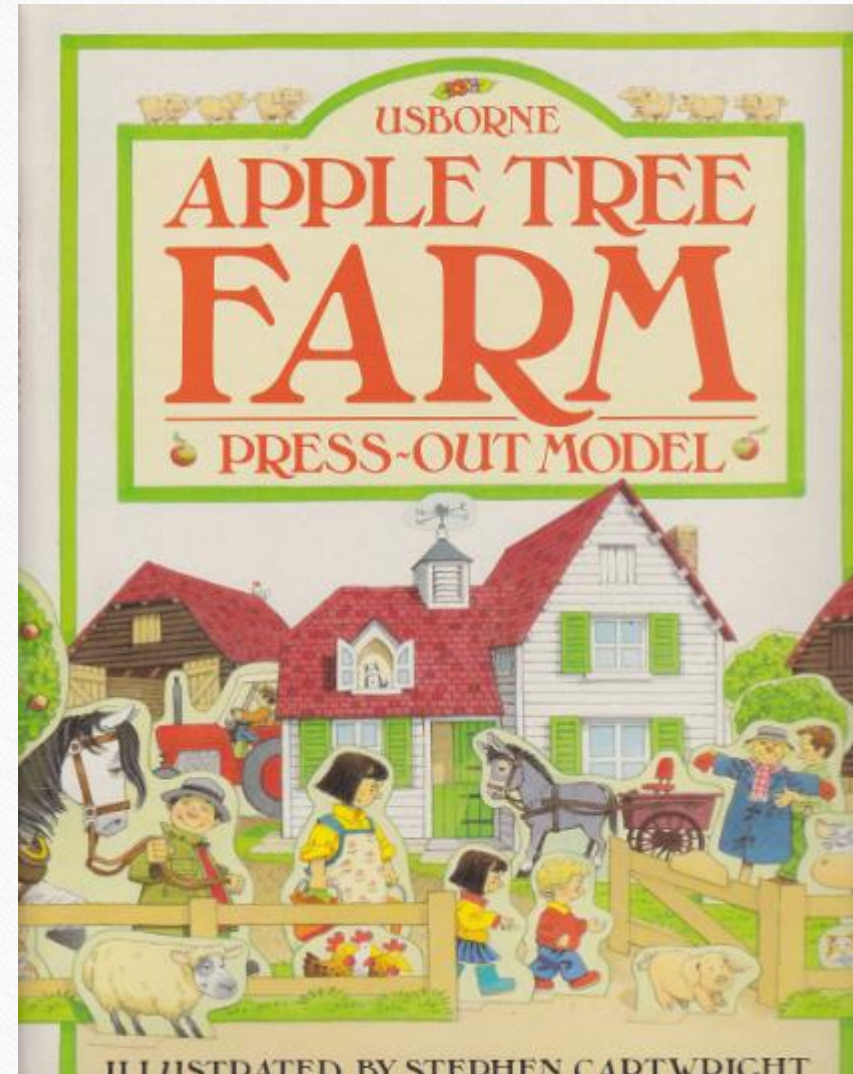

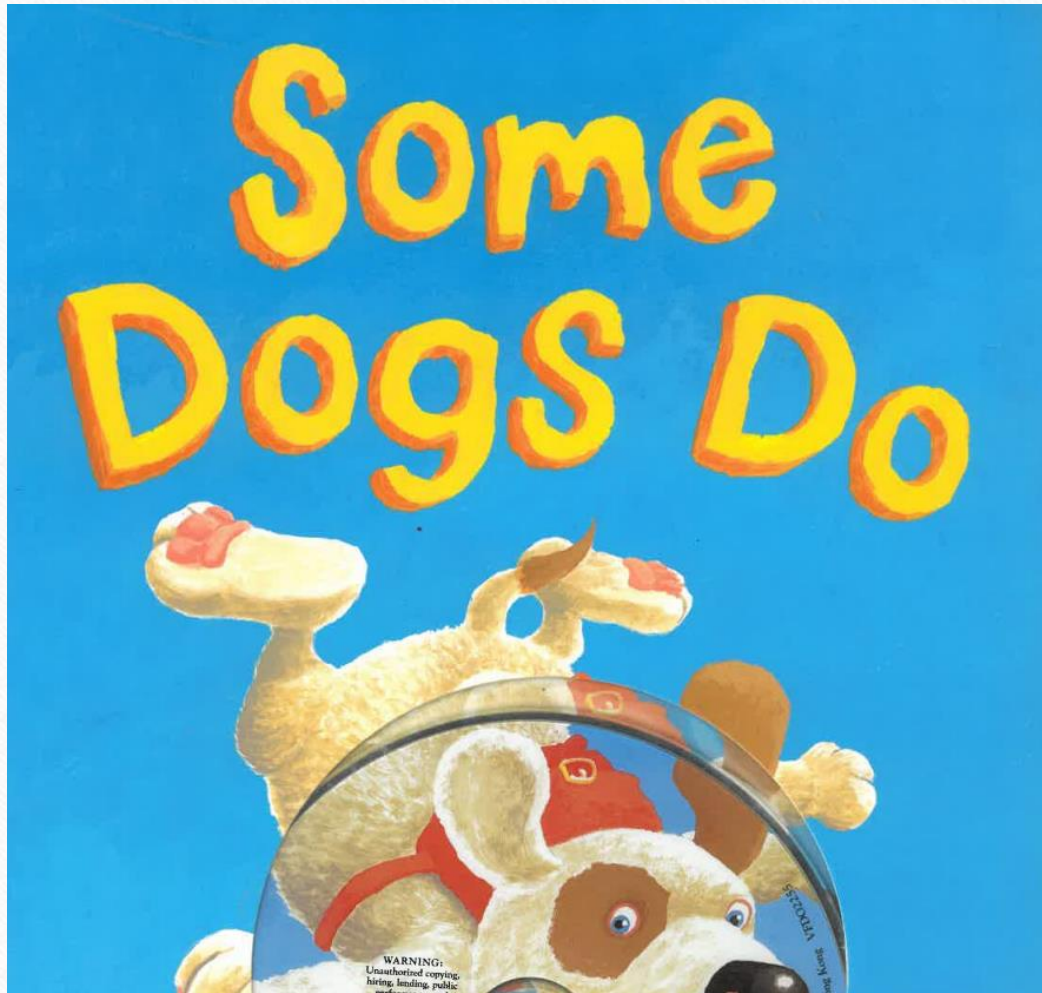
My favourite book is a series called “Apple Tree Farm.”

They always go on some sort of adventure and the pictures are fab!

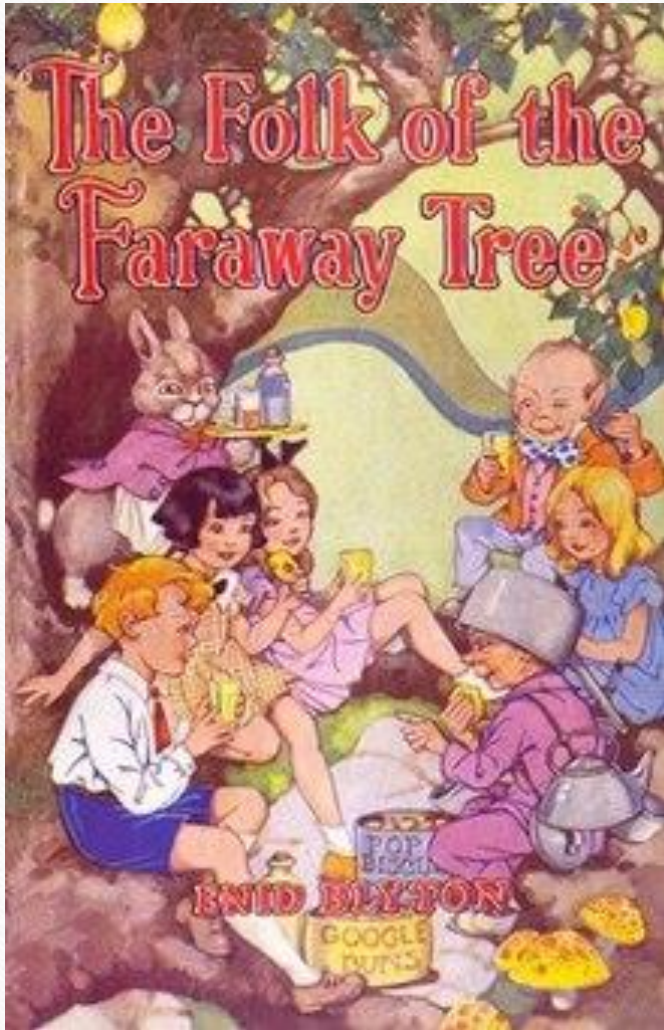
Whose favourite book could this be?
