You said...	We will...
72.5% enjoy learning RE	Continue to make the lessons fun, engaging and relevant
98.5% learn about Christianity	Continue to make it clear which religion is being taught
89.8% learn about faiths of different people in our school	Ask those children of other faiths if they would like to talk about what they believe. Otherwise, invite people of other faiths to talk to the children.
95.7% learn new words in RE linked to faith	Make sure that new words are prominently displayed beyond their immediate use.
89.8% feel able to talk about what you believe in	Ensure that everyone can speak about their own experience – whether it be with faith or without.
92.8% listen to other points of view	Ensure that others' points of view are listened to and that how this is done is clearly modelled by adults.
75.3% say that RE helps develop worldview	Model for the children, and encourage them to think more actively beyond our school walls/ immediate community boundaries/county/country
75.4% have the chance to visit places of worship	Arrange visits to other places of worship and compare and contrast between religions and, in Christianity, denominations.
88.4% enjoy collective worship	Ensure that worship is engaging and active
39.1% have the chance to lead worship	Encourage children to lead in class worship. Encourage classes to lead whole school worship, inviting parents to watch. Develop understanding of what it means to lead both in the class situation and whole school.
78.3% can talk about some stories from the Bible and what they mean	Use the stories in the Bible to highlight for all people what can be learned and what they may mean
68.1% say that teachings from the Bible help me make choices in my everyday life	
81.2% know how to make a difference in the world	Encourage everyone that every action, no matter how small, can make a difference on a local or global scale.
95.6% have time to reflect in worship	Ensure reflection time is clear during worship
94.2% are given time to pray to God in worship	Continue to use set prayers and encourage those who wish to say their own prayers during prayer time
75.3% enjoy visiting our local church	Visit local church and compare and contrast with other denominations and traditions
56.5% say that attending a church school makes a difference to you.	Continue to demonstrate the Christian ethos and how it impacts upon learning.
