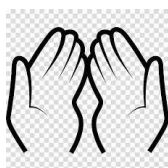
SEESAW MESSAGING

Questions about behaviour or incidents in school should be directed to the classteacher through admin@clive.shropshire.sch.uk only. Thankyou.

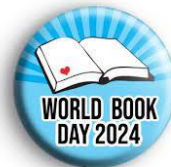
PRAYER GROUP

SANDWICHES
