As the weather gets warmer please ensure that the children bring a hat to school and suncream (which only they must use and self-apply). **Water**



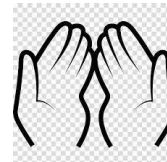

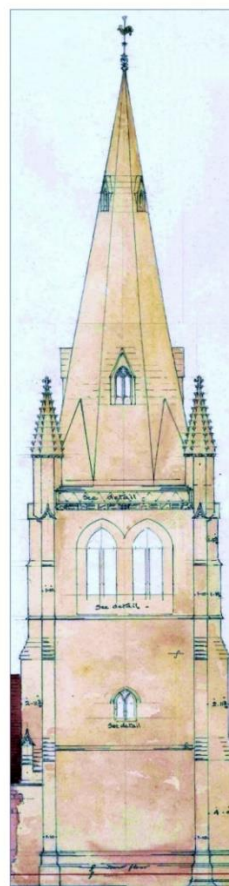
