**bottles are also essential.** Please also ensure your child(ren) has(have) a hat in school for break times - a legionnaire type or wide brimmed hat is best.

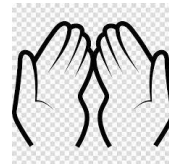

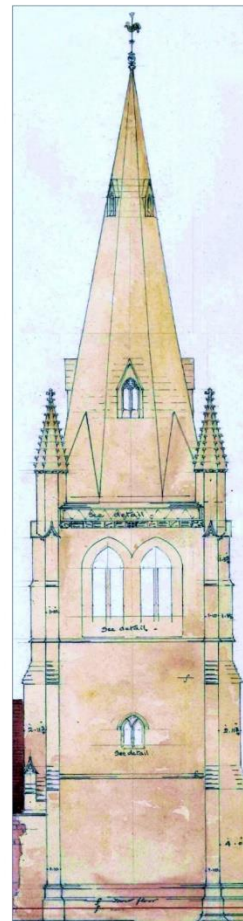
