Terminology:

Learning <u>difficulty</u> is a specific struggle with one area resulting in a 'spikey' profile.

Learning <u>disability</u> is lifelong and means there are struggles across all areas.

Parent carer: Children and Families Act (2014) defines a parent carer as "a person aged 18 or over who provides or intends to provide care for a disabled child for whom the person has parental responsibility". Note - this is slightly different to the term parent/carer that is often used in school.
