Dear Parents and Carers,

A lot of time is spent in school talking about our three values - Respect, Responsibility and Resilience. This may be during Worship, PSHE lessons, Woodland School sessions and generally in all areas of life. We discuss the importance of respecting one another, adults, personal property, the environment, the churchyard and all areas of the local community. The children are encouraged to take responsibility for looking after each other and self, the environment and other people's property. When mistakes are made, we encourage the children to be resilient, accept consequences and work to not repeat the same mistakes.

There have been occasions, recently, when children have not followed the 3 Rs. Branches have been found broken off trees, individuals have been climbing the wall on Renshaw's Field, accessing the wooded area along the driveway down Whitley's drive, behaving in a way in the churchyard that is felt to be disrespectful.
