Updated menus are available on the website. The menus will be reviewed for the summer menu. We shall be canvassing the children over the next couple of weeks for their favourites and dislikes.

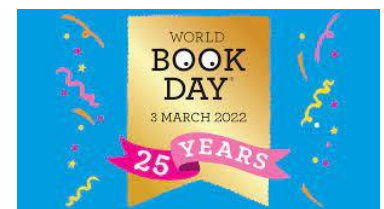
Please make sure your catering purse is regularly topped up.
